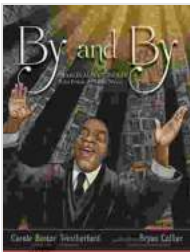


Charles Albert Tindley: The Father of Gospel Music

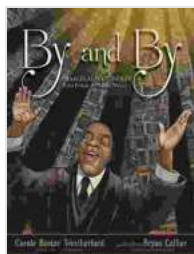

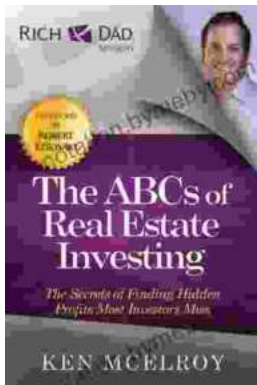
